

V. The verb Ir - to go: [ir + a + destination = to go somewhere]

A.	yo voy	- I go	nosotros vamos	- we go
	tú vas	- you go		
	él	- he goes	ellos	- they go
	ella	- she goes	ellas	- they go
	usted	- you go	ustedes	- you [pl] go

B. The present tense can translate as I go, I do go, I am going, etc.

Ella va a la clase. She goes to class, does go, is going.

C. Questions with ir + a: [to be going somewhere]

¿Adónde va usted? [Where are you going?] Yo voy a la clase.

¿Adónde vas? [Where are you going?] Voy al restaurante.

¿Adónde van Miguel y Linda? [Where are M and L going?] Van a casa.

D. Contraction: a + el = al Ella va al hospital. [a + el hospital]
